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

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
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# The Language of Eden



This book is about the most important message ever communicated to man.

Happily, we have a trustworthy English translation of the revelation preserved in the Hebrew Scriptures.

We all know that this revelation was originally written in an ancient language.

Few have considered that this ancient language pre-dates all other languages on the earth. Even fewer have deeply considered the history of this language from a biblical perspective.

If you take the time to learn the twenty-two "letters" in the modern Hebrew Aleph-Beyt, you would find it difficult to perceive the majority of ancient pictographs that originally were the foundations for each of the current modern Hebrew symbols.

Take a look at the modern Hebrew script that composes the 22 letter Aleph-Beyt, and see if you can discern the original ancient pictographs that these modern symbols replaced.

Most western readers, at this point, are probably tempted to close the book and move on to something they can more readily get their heads around.

The Hebrew language does look a little daunting.

I do understand that you might be wondering if you're in over your head. I certainly thought so when I began to investigate this over a decade ago.

If you're having doubts about going forward with this investigation, I would like to encourage you with this simple promise: *Before you finish* this chapter, you will be able to identify the meaning of each and every one of the letters in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt.

I make this promise because I know it is true.

As a matter of fact, a child eight or more years of age without any prior knowledge or familiarity with Hebrew language will be able to identify at first glance the majority of these symbols. And, after a brief explanation they will be able to identify them effortlessly.

It is at this point that we begin our investigation of the most amazing "hidden in plain sight" revelatory miracles to be re-discovered in the 21st century.

I now invite you to take a look at what is commonly known as the Proto-Canaanite language. This is the language that we know as *Hebrew*.

While the term Proto-Canaanite is helpful, it does not convey the full history of the language we know today as Hebrew — a language that predates King David, Joshua, Moses, Abraham, Noah, Enoch, and finally Seth, the son of Adam.

What you're about to view is the picture-by-picture script that was revealed by God to Moses.

This original Divine revelation was first carved into stone by Moses, copied on papyrus by the scribes, and even etched into clay tablets and pottery producing what we know as the *Torah*.

You are now looking at the original pictographs that accurately display what Moses chiseled into stone to produce what we now know as the



first five books of the Bible starting with Genesis and ending with Deuteronomy.

Now, you're probably wondering how we can know this with 100% certainty.

That is a very important question and one that will be thoroughly answered in this book. I cannot take credit for discovering the answer to this question because it was only my curiosity and a bit of sleuthing that easily uncovered the one thing that holds all of this together.

What is that one thing?

Why it is God, the revelator, of course.



He in His wisdom has solved this issue so there can be no dispute about it.

It is almost as if He knew ahead of time that there would be several ways you could hide this revelation, and He made sure that could not happen. I am speaking tongue-in-cheek as obviously God did preserve the foundational under-pinings of His first revelation to mankind.


You will laugh when you learn how He did it. It is **PURE GENIUS!** 



You can look forward to reading all about it as you study this book. This is just one more gem to be put in your pocket as a reward for persevering into what only looks like a daunting investigation.

In the end, you will discover that this revelation was not designed to intrigue the scholars or great minds of the east and west. There is no hidden code to be unlocked by some incantation of the Hebrew letters as is falsely imagined by the would-be magicians that call themselves *Kabbalists*.

This is so simple a child can understand it and perhaps that is exactly the audience God had in view.



So, please continue this quest with the promise that you will be rewarded with the keys that will allow you to unlock the heart and mind of God in ways you never thought possible. This is no intrusion into the mystery of



God. It has been revealed as an invitation so that you might know Him, and to know Him is to love Him, as He intended you to do.

You will discover nothing unorthodox in this book. Everything you will learn simply amplifies and magnifies the over-arching theme of God's revelation.

And, what is that majestic theme?

It is His Son the Messiah, Jesus the Christ, who is the only begotten Son of God — God Incarnate!

Now, take a few minutes to look at the original pictures or pictographs that were revealed to Moses symbol-by-symbol. This is God's language revealed to mankind. You will notice one addition. A good teacher always looks for ways to layer in new information that is foundational to the teaching. I will try my best to be a good teacher.

In the original picture, God assigned a number to each of the Hebrew pictographs. He did this in order to magnify the revelation. So, what you're looking at is not a modern addition as it was present from the beginning and included in the revelation we call the Old Testament.

The numbers go from 1 to 10 then 20 to 100 then finally 100 to 400.

The very first decimal system was not invented by the Persians but by God Himself.

What do these numbers mean?

The answer will be explored more fully as you go forward, but the easiest way to understand it is that the numbers were a progressive revelation based on how those numbers were used in the holy Scriptures, from Genesis through Revelation.

Some of those numbers are easy to understand and their meaning is known by most Christians. The number **3** has the meaning of **DIVINE** 

**PERFECTION**, number **7 DIVINE COMPLETION**, **10 ORDINAL PERFECTION**, and **12 GOVERNMENTAL PERFECTION**. These four numbers are well known and have been called "Sacred Numbers" as they have special significance that is well understood.

In addition, the number **5** is commonly known as the number of **GRACE**. The number **40** is known as the number of **TESTING & PROBATION**. The number **50** is known as the number of **JUBILEE**.

The number **100** is well known as the number of **PROMISE** to the Children of Israel. (Remember that Abraham was 100 years old when the Child of Promise, ISAAC, was born.)

There are many well-trusted and popular study books on the topic of the spiritual significance of numbers. Most prominently, I would invite you to investigate the published works of the following men who have done a great job of faithfully uncovering the spiritual significance of numbers, as they are used in the Holy Bible and in the Bible alone. (E.W. Bullinger) No outside sources are used.

Now, let's take a look at the language of the Garden of Eden, the language we know today as Hebrew. The only pure language in the world. That is not my opinion, it is God's. Read what God told Zephaniah, the prophet. This would be the language spoken by the children of Israel when God returned them to Israel after they had been scattered.

#### ZEPHANIAH 3:9

For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the Lord, to serve him with one consent.

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So, now that you have completed this exercise, I think you will agree that the symbols and their pictographic meaning are present in the ancient language of the Garden of Eden.

However, you're probably wondering who decided what some of the less obvious pictures meant?

It is pretty clear that Tav $^{\dagger}$  is a picture of Crossed Wooden Sticks.

It is not as obvious that Gimel \( \subseteq \) is a Camel. Who decided that the symbol of Gimel was a symbol of a Camel and not a leaning tree or a giraffe?

The answer, as disclosed earlier, is that GOD decided!

How exactly did God work that out?

How can we be sure that the pictures have remained the same after over 6000 years from the time God gifted Adam with the phonetic, picture and number language we know today as Hebrew?

The answer is eloquently simple.

God named each symbol. The name each symbol bears is either the name or the ancient root of the Hebrew name of the picture. This is not speculation. It is a linguistic and historical matter of fact.

God Himself preserved the meaning of the symbols so that even if they were modified, as He knew they would be, the picture would remain for those who took the time and effort to figure it out. This is not difficult to do.

There are three facts that are indisputable and the foundational bedrock of this book.

- 1 The first language gifted to Adam is actually three languages in one. It was FIRST a PHONETIC LANGUAGE to be used in the same conventional way that any language, including English, is used. Concepts are imbedded in words that are then used as the foundational basis of communication. The language of the Garden of Eden was a PHONETIC LANGUAGE.
- The language gifted to Adam was **SECONDLY** a picture language. It was first translated into script for the purpose of communicating by way of writing as a **PICTOGRAPHIC LANGUAGE**. The difference between the Aleph-Beyt of the Language of the Garden and English is simple. In English you learn phonetic words made up of letters that have an agreed upon meaning. The word *apple* in English is a combination of five

letters that we learn mean an apple. The Language of the Garden is made up of individual pictures that are displayed as pictographs or symbols that are learned in order to compose a concept based on each picture. God has preserved this picture in order that we might investigate them with humility and reverence.


The language gifted to Adam was **THIRDLY** a **NUMERIC LANGUAGE**. A language that was meant to be investigated numerically as it yielded up its meaning as the revelation of the Scriptures progressed. We now have the complete revelation and the complete record of how God used numbers for His prophetic purposes.

These are the three principle facts that give us courage to carefully and humbly explore the meaning of not only the phonetic revelation but also the pictorial and the numeric revelations. Together they are self-authenticating, magnifying, and amplifying levels of Divine revelation. They are all in harmony with one another in order to declare God's Divine supernatural purposes for his entire creation. A creation that is even now groaning for the manifestation of the sons of God.

Let's add one more element to the 22 pictographs we call the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt.

This is done for the purpose of locking into your mind the pictures that God placed in front of the first man to see them, Moses, and all who followed up to the time of Daniel the prophet. While Daniel was a captive in Babylon, the Hebrew pictograms you see in the next chapter were *modified* or *updated* by the Hebrew Scribes who were banished to Babylon for their idolatry and unbelief.

Let's take another look at the pictures embedded in each Hebrew letter as we consider the genius of God's chosen method of communication with sinful and fallen mankind.

#### An Ox is always an Ox


The symbol or picture of the Ox might change from (proto-Canaanite) to (Moses) based on the medium used to scribe the pictogram, but the concept is retained in both symbols.

It became a matter of settling on which symbol to use in order to promote unity without deviation. Once used, it would become a well understood and accepted tradition.

Everyone knew what the symbol meant; Aleph was always an Ox and there was not one other of the 22 letters that could be confused with it.

#### Newer is not always better!

I do not know what or who "inspired" the Scribes, who were taken into captivity in Babylon, to alter the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt in order to conform it to the Aramaic Block Script. Perhaps, they thought it would be a good idea to *modernize* the ancient Aleph-Beyt to be in line with the script used by the rest of the nations.





Hasn't this always been one of Israel's problems?

Perhaps, it was an attempt by Satan to sabotage the revelation of Scripture or at least make it more difficult to trace its origins back to its ancient and original roots. This was malevolently motivated by the fact that these original roots were bathing in the pure water of God's revelation.

Or, perhaps there is a more innocent explanation.

Whatever the reason, the results are obvious.

A barrier has been erected that makes it more difficult to apprehend the pictures that were embedded in the Hebrew letters.

Obviously, the changes did not completely obscure the original pictures, but they did alter the original pictures in a way that now requires an extra layer of information in order to discover the root picture meaning of Hebrew words.



As you can see, the early Hebrew pictograms, which were in use up until the Babylonian captivity, were pretty simple to figure out. And, once learned, a child could write and remember them with ease.

Remembering details is high on God's list of things He wanted man to master.

The pictographic Hebrew retained an obvious connection between the symbol and what it was symbolizing up until the Babylonian captivity.







From that point in time, we are told to forget the old as it no longer has meaning.

#### And now you know why we us the ancient Hebrew symbols!

The supernatural perspective, that is the bedrock foundation of this book, is informed by the ancient prophetic Scriptures that we call the Old and New Testament.

We believe that the living Word of God was the only thing that left the Garden of Eden unmolested after the treachery of sin and rebellion entered into the heart of Adam.




The language of the Garden of Eden is a miraculous language that contains the seed plot for all human existence and cradles the one hope, the only hope, that mankind can reliably depend upon.

I do not believe, and could never be persuaded to believe, that **THE WORD OF GOD** was birthed in the belly of the "Beast of Babylon" in the Valley of Shinar, during the Satanic reign of Nimrod.

I do not believe the Hebrew language is the step-child of the corrupted post-Babel languages of the Phoenicians, Akkadians, and Egyptians.







Even when modified to conform to the modern block Aramaic language, the language of the Babylonian captivity, the core integrity of the letters is preserved.

The final proof is in the ancient Hebrew text, in the symbols and in the numbers.

Do they yield nonsense and confusion when they are examined by God's children?

Or, are they a source of comfort and encouragement consistent with the biblical revelation?

Does the simple picture language magnify God and His only begotten Son?

Do you hear the Master's voice amplified in the simple pictures and numbers that foundationally compose the Hebrew words?

Is there anything in the pictures or numbers that is in conflict with the phonetic revelation we know as conventional Hebrew? A language that God has graciously given us so that we might discover His Son, in order that we might be delivered from the wrath of God.

There has always been a remnant that believed, cherished, and published the message. But, sadly, the very people who were separated out of all the nations and commissioned to make the message known to the entire world have themselves been blinded in part to the purpose and power of the revelation.

This book is a call to men of faith to rediscover the majesty and power of the first revelation God gifted man. The revelation was miraculously gifted to the first man, Adam, in order that he might have fellowship and communion with his Creator. This language was not learned but bestowed on the mind of Adam in order that Adam might know and understand the mind and heart of God.

The Language of the Garden of Eden is a language like no other.

It is a language with three-parts, each magnifying and amplifying the other.

Three languages woven into one and originally communicated in somewhat the same way you might watch a silent movie with a written storyline underneath the moving picture.

This is a poor example as it does not capture the full experience that Adam must have had communicating with his Creator. But, it does get us on the path to understanding the indisputable fact that the language of the Garden of Eden was audible and phonetic, pictographic and numeric — all at the same time!

A pure language was integrated seamlessly into the uncorrupted mind of Adam. Adam was not confused by the conversations he had with God. Adam enjoyed sweet fellowship with his Creator in the cool of the evening, while residing without sin in the wonderous Garden of Eden.

And, the first task God set Adam's mind to was based on this new gift of language. Adam named **ALL** the animals.

The Garden is gone. But, one thing remains — the majestic and glorious subject of this book.

Will you be as able and capable as Adam in your understanding of the first written revelation given to mankind? A revelation revealed pictogram-by-pictogram, as we would say, letter-by-letter to Moses who scribed it just exactly as God revealed it.

The answer is "of course not". We do not have Adam's intelligence or the purity of thought given to Adam before he sinned. And, yet, the revelation remains for our investigation.

Even through our mesh of sin filters that corrupt good communication, even with our diminished intelligence, and even with our sinful nature, we can still glean the field of revelation found in the Old Testament originally written down in the language of the Garden. A language that has retained 6000 years later the very symbols and pictures that God downloaded into



the mind of Adam. Pictures that remained as the pictographic text of the Holy Scriptures up until the time of the Babylonian captivity. Even with the alteration of the symbols while in Babylon, the picture God created for each letter miraculously remains by God's sovereign will to this very day.

It is my belief that we are living in the days prophesied by Daniel. This is the time of *the end* when things hidden may be finally revealed.

God's revelation has not and never will change.

What does change is man's ability to comprehend the revelation with an understanding that is supernatural in origin. If you do not believe that then please read what Jesus said as reported in the Gospel of Matthew.

The Hebrew language with its pictures all strung together with **NO** capital letters, **NO** periods, **NO** commas, or any other punctuation or separation has been translated into English based on the phonetic understanding of the text. This is, of course, part of God's gracious plan to keep His revelation in front of mankind.

If you consult a Hebrew Interlinear you can see the modern Hebrew text with spaces added to accommodate the definition of the original pictographs that have been consolidated into thoughts and expressed as words.

What if you took the time to look at the pictures that make up the individual Hebrew words? What if you re-translated those modern symbols to their original pictograms?

You would discover a picture language that even a child, a babe, could understand.

The purpose of this book is not to impress anyone with a complicated coded messaging system that can only be understood by a few.

The purpose of this book is to introduce you to a revelation that was given to man so that he might be redeemed in order to renew his fellowship and friendship with his Creator.



The message of redemption was "baked into the cake," as it were.

What will you discover when you begin examining the pictures God revealed as one of three foundations in His written revelation to man?

You will discover a revelation that has been amazingly designed to have one grand theme and one theme only.

That theme is expressed in thousands of ways, much the way a diamond reflects a thousand facets when held up to light.

What is that grand theme?

It is the magnification and amplification of the Son of God, Jesus the Christ, who became Immanuel (the God-man) in order to offer the pure blood sacrifice required to quench the wrath of God.

The theme of the entire Old Testament is Christ — the appointed one who came to save us from the wrath that will come on all those who refuse God's gracious plan of salvation, which is based on the blood sacrifice of His only begotten Son, Jesus the Christ.

This is not over-blown hyperbole. This is a fact that you will soon come in contact with if you continue to read this book. I know you have lots of questions. Since I began this journey, almost a decade ago, I have asked many of the questions on your mind. By the time you finish reading this book, I believe those questions will be addressed and answered.



The commonly held belief, among those who deny the veracity and literal interpretation of biblical history, is that Hebrew is a simple, unsophisticated, subordinate language that evolved from the more advanced blending of the Sumerian and the Akkadian Semitic languages.

From the fusion of these two languages, we are supposed to believe the Hebrew language had its beginning.

Many, who promote this historical linguistic theory, teach that all the stories found in the first five books of the Bible were simply "borrowed" and "re-fashioned" from the myths that were prevalent in the region of Mesopotamia.

Some, who are sympathetic to the biblical account, teach that, while the events recorded in Genesis may be generally relied upon, the actual original words used to record the events wriggled out of the pagan languages that "progressively developed" in the region of Sumer, also refered to as the Plains of Shinar.

These theories deny the unique creation account found in Genesis.

Not surprisingly, most deny that there was a literal Adam and Eve.

As can be expected, those that hold the "borrowed language" theory mock the notion that Hebrew is the first language spoken on the earth.

According to this corrupted history of the earth, all things, including the Hebrew language, sprang from Sumer in Mesopotamia and are subordinate to its pagan history and mythos.

This is the anti-supernatural position taken by almost all of those who do not believe that the Scriptures are a unique divine revelation from the LORD God who made the heavens and the earth, created Adam in His own image, and gifted him with the pure uncorrupted language we know today as Hebrew.

When is the last time you met an Acadian, had lunch with an Ammonite, or celebrated Moabite Monday?

Of all the languages that fall into the category of Canaanite languages, including Phoenician, Acadian, Punic, Babylonian, Amorite, Ammonite, Moabite, Edomite, and many more, only one ancient language miraculously exists to this day.

If you believe that the ancient prophetic Scriptures are a revelation from Almighty God then you already know, based on the prophetic word, what language miraculously exists while all the other Canaanite languages are extinct.

Is Hebrew a crude unpolished language that owes its origins to the Sumerian, Egyptians, Chinese, or Phoenician pictographic languages?

As evidence that the answer is *yes*, language scholars point out the complexity of those pictographic languages and assume that Hebrew, with its simple childlike pictures, must have been an inferior "spin off" of the more sophisticated and complex pictographic languages that sprang forth as man progressed into more intelligent and technologically advanced people groups.

Only orthodox Jews and a small remnant of Christians rely on a literal interpretation of the Scriptures for their worldview. Most of those in this small subset of "biblical literalist" are convinced that all languages, including the Egyptian, Sumerian, and Chinese, while obviously similar in some ways, owe their beginning to the original language of the Garden of Eden, not the other way around.

### The Miracle of Chaos and Confusion

If we take a look at this question from a biblical perspective, the history of language is clearly outlined, logical, and simple to understand.

### **GENESIS 11:1, 7**

And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech.
Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.



### **GENESIS 11:9**

Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the Lord did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the Lord scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.

According to the Bible, all the languages on the earth, except the language of the Garden of Eden, were confused and corrupted languages that all had miraculous beginnings at the Tower of Babel.

If you find it hard to believe that the first man, Adam, was graciously gifted with the language of the Garden of Eden (the language we now call Hebrew), you're probably not going to believe that the same God took away the pure language of the Garden of Eden and replaced it with scores of corrupted, scrambled, and confused languages that were all obviously similar but not the same.





We begin with the premise that God created one pure language in the beginning. God compensated the wicked post flood generations by giving them the wages they had earned for the treacherous acts of sin and rebellion they demonstrated at the Tower of Babel.

God took from man the one pure language of the Garden of Eden and exchanged it for corrupted languages that sent them scurrying all over the earth with scrambled languages that allowed to man to coalesce in accordance with the commandment the Lord gave to Noah and his sons.

# GENESIS 9:1 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.

### We can do this the easy way or the hard way!

In the end, the rebels of Babel unwillingly obeyed God's instructions to multiply and replenish the earth. The only difference was that they ended up doing so without the light of God's pure language. The LORD gave them what they wanted. The LORD gave them confused languages that would allow them to wallow in their blindness and unbelief.

The corruption of the pure language of the Garden of Eden resulted in a corruption of everything that was good. The cities and nations that developed after the flood even corrupted the creation story, giving themselves over to myths, fables, and fiction. They joined themselves to the rebellious angelic rebels and demons that had lost their preferred places in God's kingdom. They replaced worship of the only true living God with bondage to false gods and every unclean spirit that roams the earth. If they were to wallow in their blindness and unbelief, they would do so without the Lord's pure language.





So, the Lord scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city.

In short, God left the "Babylonian Conspirators" answerable to their own evil imagination and devices within the boundaries of His permissive will.

### What about the Language of Eden, the Language of the Garden?

God preserved His pure language, as a perpetual inheritance, to be kept unspotted and separate by a small remnant, who he would sustain forever. To the first "People of the Book" God made promises and covenants which guaranteed their survival and eventual status as a unique nation purposed with declaring His Word. By so doing, God insured the continuance of His Word in order that all men might have a witness of the Truth.

Is this why we still have the Hebrew language intact to this very day?



## CHAPTER 6

# Original Hebrew Untangles Modern Confusion





There is no confusion with the Lord God. God is not the author of confusion. And, in the end, it has no place in His kingdom.

Does God use confusion to further His gracious purposes?

We know He does.

The promise that all Christians so glibly parrot without acting like they really believe it, proves the point.

What promise is that?



#### ROMANS 8:28

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

The simple truth is that, while things may appear to be simply awful and headed in the wrong direction, the LORD can work it out so that it is good.

The short view of the life of Joseph is the paradoxical preamble to the end of the story of Joseph.

What was meant for evil God miraculously worked out for good.

Only God can turn something planned by His enemies to damage Him or His loved ones into something very good.

Adding helium to a balloon does not change the balloon, it only makes it swell up and fly high.

Have you ever noticed how easy it is to find evidence that bolsters the ungodly opinions and theories of those that rudely mock and scoff at the very idea of a good Creator God?



Do you think this is just an unfortunate accident?


Or, does it further the purposes of God to allow those who do not love Him to find reasons to doubt His very existence?

Does God give those who hate Him the spirit of boldness in order that they might reflect outwardly and display openly what is hidden inside their minds and hearts?

We read in the English Bible that God "hardened" Pharaoh's heart. And, from that one mistranslated verse we have bolstered an entire theological viewpoint that coalesces around a complete distortion of the sovereignty of God.

Fortunately, God preserved His words, which can be read in the original Hebrew language to this day.


When we investigate the original Hebrew word translated into English as "hardened," found seven times between **Exodus 10:1** and **Exodus 14:17**, what do we find?





We discover that the Hebrew word **Chet Zayin Qoof**, the word translated as "hardened" in English is translated as "steadfast" in the original Hebrew.

We find the same Hebrew word Chet Zayin Qoof in Deuteronomy 31:6.



God did not *change* Pharaoh's heart, he simply gave Pharaoh the courage to express it without fear. Pharaoh's heart was fortified or strengthened; it was not altered or amended.

Pharaoh was given the spirit of resoluteness that resulted in him being steadfast in his convictions.

God did not harden Pharaoh's heart. Instead, He allowed what was already in Pharaoh's heart to manifest in a way that was bold and courageous.

The wickedness of Pharaoh's heart was fully revealed and displayed so that there could be no question about where Pharaoh's heart was anchored.

Pharaoh was an enemy of God, and God wanted everyone to know it.

How many times have I heard Christians wonder out loud why God didn't make the genesis of His creation undeniably and completely crystal clear as well as in harmony with all the latest scientific knowledge?

How much easier evangelism would be if there was only one creation account — the one revealed by the Creator, proven with evidence and believed by all.

Obviously, God has a better way of sorting out those that love and trust Him from those that do not. For those who do not love God or want Him to rule over them, the Lord allowed ambivalence and blindness as a way of justifying their decisions. There is plenty of evidence that bolsters faith, but God has allowed it to co-exist with "false evidence" and easy to believe lies in order to test the heart of man.

### Has an AH-HA moment arrived?

While we are musing about that question, let's reflect on why God allowed one third of the angels in Heaven to exercise their freewill by both believing and following Lucifer.

It seems to me that a simple, overwhelming glorious moment of revelation and demonstration of power would have put that entire process to a sudden and final end.

Short of Divine intervention, you might think that given the perfect context of Heaven, with all its glorious testimony to the majesty and righteousness of God, that a rebellion based on slanderous lies and skillful misrepresentations would not find a willing audience.







But it did!

What was the Lord thinking?

Is this why the Lord put one single tree in the Garden of Eden whose delicious looking fruit man as forbidden to eat?

Did God want Adam to sin?

The answer is absolutely NOT!

Adam was put in the Garden because God desired to test Adam's heart to see if he loved Him alone, or if Adam's affections lay elsewhere.



God's purpose in allowing evil is not as perplexing as man imagines.

Consider an earthly example of a heavenly strategy!

If you have ever run a business large or small then at some point you may find yourself in the position of dealing with a slanderous arrogant employee who thinks he or she can do it better than you can.

You can fire that person on the spot and try to contain the damage this employee's slander has created, or you can let it run its course.

What would be the advantage of letting slanderous lies continue?

Can you figure it out?

The rebel will infect the minds of others putting their loyalty and devotion to the person signing their pay checks and providing for their families to the **TEST**!

You can guess the rest.

What better way to cleanse an organization of the "Absaloms" than to let the insurrection run its course in order to draw out the cancer of rebellion and disloyalty?


Once everyone has revealed their true hearts, then is the time to disassociate yourself from the rebels and reward the faithful, cleansing and purifying your domain.

You might even find yourself secretly allowing the rebel to make progress. Does that make you responsible for the sins of the rebel? Of course not. It simply means that you are speeding up the process of "discovery". This process of discovery will lead to the day when all will be set right again in your domain. You will be surrounded by people whose love and devotion was tested and remained faithful.

If you can see the advantages of such a strategy in an earthly enterprise, do you really think it would not have the same wonderful consequence in the kingdom of Heaven?













## Back to the Garden of Eden



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Now let's go back to the topic of the one pure language that emerged unmolested from the Garden of Eden. The language that still exists today is a testimony to the miracle working power of our God and His covenant to redeem mankind through His anointed Messiah.

What does the "history of language" look like if we believe and trust God and have confidence in what He has revealed to us?


We would operate under a completely different historical timeline and perspective — the one outlined in the ancient prophetic Scriptures that we call the Old Testament.

The history of language that emerges from a "Biblical" vantage point gives us complete confidence that the language spoken by Adam and Eve, as they communicated face to face with God, is the same language God revealed in over 99% of the ancient prophetic Scriptures we know as the Old Testament.



#### **ZEPHANIAH 3:9**

For then will I turn to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the Lord, to serve him with one consent.



Have you ever wondered why Satan spends so much time on false prophecy?

How many false prophets have been raised up in the service of the Dark Prince?

I would venture to guess thousands, and they keep coming.

Why?

I will answer the question with a question.

Why does the enemy of a country imitate, publish, and circulate false facsimiles of their legal currency?

The answer is simple. The abundance of counterfeit currency reduces the value and creates suspicion about the bona-fide currency.

For millennium some Bible scholars speculated and wondered what pure language God had in mind for the last days.

God has miraculously regathered His scattered chosen people from every nation on earth.

Of what "pure language" do they speak?

The re-gathering, foretold by the prophet Zephaniah, happened in 1948. We can now bear witness to the fulfillment of the prophecy of Zephaniah as it has unfolded in time as a real historical event.

I can report with 100% confidence that the pure language speculation has been solved. The language spoken in regathered Israel today is Hebrew, the same language that Adam spoke in the Garden of Eden.

It is the same language that was preserved on Noah's Ark. The same pure language preserved after God confused the languages at the Tower of Babel.

There is nothing in the Scriptures that even hints that the language spoken in the Garden of Eden was not the same language that crossed over on the ark with Noah. The language of the Garden was the same language that was spoken at the time Nimrod began building the Tower of Babel.

There were not multiple languages spoken in the pre-diluvium age, only one language was spoken.



The language spoken was the language gifted to Adam from the moment he was created.

The same can be said of the first language spoken by all the inhabitants of the newly washed earth up until the time God confused His one pure language at the Tower of Babel.

So, if you think that God confused the "pure language" during the reign of Nimrod on the earth, you are correct.

If you think that the language spoken in the Garden ceased to exist after the confusion of languages at the Tower of Babel, then you are mistaken.

### The Proof Provided by Longevity

Noah, who lived to be 950 years old, and his sons and grandsons were alive and well during the era of Nimrod. They lived to see, with their own eyes, the episode recorded in the Bible under the title of The Tower of Babel.

Simple logic and the historical record, as reported in both the Holy Scriptures and the book of Jasher (referenced several times in the Old Testament and noted in the Scriptures as a reliable account of history), shows the fact that Noah and his immediate family did not participate in the building of Nimrod's tower.

Why do we not find this hard to believe?

Noah and his righteous remnant, who were present on the earth at the time of Nimrod's rebellion, did not wake up one morning speaking a foreign language. There is no evidence nor is there reason to believe that those not present, not participating, and not sanctioning the deplorable rebellion that was taking place in the Valley of Shinar ever had the Garden language removed from their hearts and minds.

There is no evidence that those NOT under the despotic and demonic rule of Nimrod ever stopped speaking the language of the Garden of Eden.



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These newly confused and corrupted languages, which caused men to migrate in all directions, had their original roots in the language of the Garden of Eden. God used these corrupted languages to coalesce the people into nation groups that no longer possessed the pure revelatory purpose of the language spoken in the Garden of Eden.

Only Noah and his family retained the precious gift first given to Adam, the language of the Garden of Eden. This language was passed

on from Noah to Shem, to Eber, and finally to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Eber is where both the language and the people derive the name Hebrew. In the language of the Garden, the letter "hey" before a noun acts as a definite article. For example, in Genesis 1:1 "the heavens" is a translation of "h'shemayim". In Hebrew, "shemayim" simply means "heavens", and when you prepend the hey, it transforms "heavens" to "the heavens". In this same way, Abram was referred to as "the Eber" or "h'ibri" (the Hebrew).

In order to provide some historical context for this event, Abram was over 50 years old when his great grandfather Noah died. When God confused the language of rebellious men at the tower of Babel, He removed from those men the language of the Garden of Eden.





Mankind had, in less than 300 years after the flood, returned to the same pagan idolatry that brought judgment on the world in the first place.

What was the judgment God decreed upon those that participated in the rebellion of Nimod at the Tower of Babel?

The answer is that the judicial judgment of God confused their language, and God thereby removed His revelatory word from their vocabulary.

They would no longer mock God in His pure language but instead be given a language that was better suited to aid them in their quest to evict the One True God from their minds and hearts.

Notice that God could have removed all language from their hearts and minds, sending men into utter darkness that would have taken millennium to cure. But, He didn't. He left them the means to openly and loudly express the desires of their wicked hearts.

Are you starting to understand one of the revealed ways that God works?

God accommodated their rebellion, giving them over to what they desired.

God would no longer tolerate those who blasphemed Him in the pure language He had created, in order to reveal His gracious plans to mankind. If they would blaspheme and imagine vain things it would be in a confused language more suited to reflect the condition of their hearts and minds.

In short, they were sentenced to a judicial spiritual blindness.

How did that work out?

The pure language was preserved by a faithful remnant that worshiped God alone and refused to become embroiled in the rebellion of Nimrod.

Noah and his family, including Shem and Eber, did not sanction or participate in the construction of Nimrod's *star-gate* designed to breach

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
the heavens in order to put them in contact with the ancient gods (fallen angels).

Do not be confused. Babel was constructed in the Plains of Shinar in order to crash the gates of Heaven, invade God's kingdom, and destroy the Creator God.














# Hebrew the Original or a Sloppy Copy?





Now let's take a look at the ancient languages of the pagan nations of Sumerian, Phoenicia, Egypt, and China.

They all began as pictographic languages full of iconic symbols that became objects of worship.

Over the ages, archeologists have unearthed many of the clay and stone mediums that display the symbols used in pagan languages. These languages sprang up without any evolutionary history.



Fallen men now communicating in a corrupted language will no doubt continue the process of corruption.

Evidence of this is not surprising. But, what is perplexing, to those that study ancient languages, is the absence of the long ages of development required by the theories that undergird modern linguistic theory.

These "corrupted" languages literally sprang up out of nowhere.

Consider the millions of intermediate skeletal remains that must be present to support the theory of evolution.

Where are they?

They simply do not exist!

All the evidence, when honestly investigated, is consistent with the Biblical record that documents the account found in the **11th chapter of Genesis**.

To be clear, there is no history or evidence of the long march of language from primitive to advanced.

Like Darwin's missing intermediary fossils, which must be present to bear witness to an evolution of a species, the same missing data is evidence that there was NO evolution of language.

Obviously, there were changes over time to accommodate modernity, but there is no evidence of the process that would have taken thousands of years to unfold with tons of evidence of how it all developed.

The pathway from mute to master of ceremony simply does not exist.

### The language of Paganism and Humanism

Now, consider the symbols or pictograms that composed the post Babel languages, that we are told were the precursors to Hebrew.

See if you can notice a pattern.

The ancient pictographic languages of the Phoenicians, Egyptians, Sumerians, Akkadians, Chinese, and all additional post-diluvium languages, which sprang up after the Tower of Bable, show the sun, moon, and stars dipected as sacred entities and objects of worship.

Man's technology, if indeed it was originated with man, is lifted up in these pagan pictographic languages that were birthed in the chaos, confusion, and pride that followed Babel.

You might think that humanism and paganism are mutually exclusive. Think again!

They regularly show up together as they are two sides to the same coin. "Enlightened" paganism is the twin brother of the priests of so-called science and technology.



There is a lot to be said by Silence!

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Compare all the above to the simple pictures that undergird the Hebrew language, the language of the Garden of Eden.

Consider the 22 pictograms of the Ox, Tent, Camel, Door, Man Lifting Up his Hands, to Look, Nail or Stake, Harvesting Tool, Garden, Sanctuary, Snake, Arm, Hand, Staff, Water, Fish or Sprout, Prop for Tree, Eye, Mouth, Hook, Back of Head, Head Person, Teeth, Wooden Cross.

Now notice what you don't see in the language of the Garden of Eden.

You do not see pictographs of wheels, spears, or arrows.

There are no ox carts, no boats, no jewelry, no slavery, no whips, no beasts of burden, no sun, no moon, no stars to worship, no palaces, no monuments to death, no graven idols, no cities, no musical instruments, no metal works, no sword play, no warfare, no chariots of war drawn by horses, no infantry, and no works of man are pictured in any of the 22 pictures that undergird the 22 letters in the Hebrew alphabet.

The simple truth is that there is not one single picture in the palate of 22 pictures that is not consistent with life in the Garden of Eden before the fall.

### Adam is not the man you think he is!

Let's return to Adam and the Garden of Eden in order to get our compass pointing in the right direction.

Our understanding and imagination need to be disabused of any preconceived image of Adam as a knuckle dragging primitive man.

Adam understood a lot more than any of us can ever imagine.

Do you have a copy machine?

Have you ever made a copy from an original?

The first copy can be pretty good.



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If you continue to make copies using the last copy as your new original, it will not be long before you end up with a copy that is a very poor distorted reflection of the original image you copied.

Comparing the original with a 10th generation copy illustrates the point I am trying to make.





Adam was created sinless. His capacities in his un-fallen state were far superior to anything we can now imagine. His intellectual capacity must have been off the charts.

The question has been asked, could Adam read and write?

The question assumes that if he could not, then he was both primitive and ignorant.

This very question does not discover ignorance — it displays ignorance.

You cannot even imagine the capacities of the first created man whose life, even after cut off from the life support of God's Spirit, took 930 days to shrivel up and finally expire.

Can you compare that to any modern examples?



Adam, if alive today, would be considered more than a freak of nature. He would be considered a little god.

Even though that description is an affront to the Creator, it would be the "natural" response of fallen man to view Adam as a superman with "godlike" capacities. There was only one first man, and He was created both sinless and with unimaginable abilities that we are simply unable to comprehend.

So, why exactly would Adam, with abilities and a memory that would put any supercomputer manufactured by modern man to shame, need to read or write?

Perhaps, Adam did know how to write.

With his ability to retain information and understand all the nuances of the language, the question is — why would Adam need to write?

Adam did not have a faulty memory. He did not need to take notes in order to ponder the mysteries Elohim revealed to him during his tenure in the Garden of Eden.

# God has plans for the future!

Here is where we come face to face with the miracle of God's pure language.

By the Creator's design, from the beginning, the language of the Garden perfectly accomplished its purpose before and after the fall of Adam.

It was a language that could easily be written down and understood.

The language of the Garden of Eden contained, from the beginning, the redemptive purpose that YHVH Elohim (the LORD God) had for man after his expulsion from the Garden of Eden.

It was a language that anticipated the fall of man without having to change a single letter, picture, or number. I know what you're thinking.

Obviously, words that were unfamiliar to Adam in the Garden of Eden would be constructed from the letters in the Hebrew alphabet in order that men might communicate in this newly fallen and changing sinful world.

Some pictures and concepts were widened in order to accommodate the new reality of man's sin. The rebellion of Adam would no doubt be reflected in the language that came out of the Garden.

The most seemingly incongruous example is the seventh Hebrew Symbol in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt.

# The meaning of the Number 7 and the Axe



Let's consider for a moment the Hebrew letter Zayin which was originally pictured as an axe and could probably serve the dual purpose as a hammer.

I have chosen this letter since it is the one symbol that is most often questioned.

The modern Hebrew letter Zayin is viewed as a symbol for a knife or sword weapon.





The weapon does not seem to be in harmony with the original symbol revealed in the Garden of Eden.

Adam did not need a sword to defend himself as there was nothing hostile living within the confines of the Garden.

So, what is this all about?

The answer to the meaning of Zayin is discovered in the number seven.

There are only nine numbers in the world, as zero is not a number but a place holder.

Of all nine numbers, there are four numbers that are considered sacred. These numbers are constantly used in the Bible as a shadow of something divine and sacred.

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The number **Three**, for example, is the sacred number that means **Divine Perfection**.

**Ten** is the number that means **Ordinal Perfection**. Ordinal Perfection simply means that something ordained in Heaven has unfolded or is unfolding on the earth. Ten is the one number that notifies us that God has plans for mankind.

Based on its usage in Scripture, we see that the number **Twelve** is the number of **Governmental Perfection**. It is the one number that is associated with God's Kingdom and the fact that one day it will be the kingdom of this world.

Isn't this what the Lord told us to pray for?

His kingdom has not arrived yet, and so we continue to pray, "May Thy Kingdom Come".



The fourth sacred number is **Seven**. Seven is used throughout the Scriptures to reveal **Devine Completion**.

So, what does all of this have to do with an axe and the number seven?



The Lesson of the Fruit Tree

Of all the tools Adam would need as the caretaker of the Garden of Eden an axe would have been the most necessary and useful.

Trees need pruning, young saplings would need to be secured to a stake with vine ropes, and fruit needs harvesting. The list could go on and on.

When harvest time arrived, the axe made from a sharp shale stone attached to a handle made from a sturdy stick and fastened by a vine rope would have been an important harvesting tool.

A sharp axe would have been used for harvesting or "cutting off" the fully ripened fruit.

If you think that all fruit is simply pulled or shaken off a fruit tree then you are probably unaware of the fact that most fruit is actually "cut" off the tree or vine. All grapes are harvested with a pruning knife. Many varieties of fruit would be damaged if they were pulled off the fruit tree, so are either clipped or cut from the tree.

When are things harvested?







The answer is when they are fully ripened. The harvest begins at exactly the right time. If you leave the fruit on the trees past the point when God designed them to be harvested what is the result?

The fruit attached to the tree would simply rot and fall off the tree where it would decay.

There is a time to harvest.

When is that time?

When the trees function of producing fruit is complete.

Do you see the principle of Divine Completion and the number seven at work?

Consider how many biblical truths are illustrated in the context of harvesting fruit. The axe was the original symbol of harvest time, the time of completion.

# When is an Axe not a Harvesting Tool?

Zayin is pictured in modern Hebrew script as a knife or a sword. In short, Zayin is pictured as not only a harvesting tool but also a weapon.



# **ZAYIN** in modern Hebrew Script

It is not hard to imagine an Axe or Hammer being used as a weapon.

The axe was not a weapon in the Garden of Eden.

Consider how the meaning of Zayin expanded after Adam was expelled from the Garden.





# The connection between being "Cut Off" and Completion!

Consider the first fruits of sin:



### **GENESIS 4:8**

And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him.

What does this have to do with Zayin?

Was something "cut off"?

The answer is yes.

The life of Abel was "cut off" by the violent act of his brother Cain.

Sin changed everything, except the language of the Garden of Eden.

God knew what was going to happen after the perfection of the Garden of Eden, and He architected His language so that it would be a light of revelation in a world darkened by the new reality of sin.

Did the fact that the axe went from being used as a harvesting tool to a weapon diminish the word of God?

No, it magnified it.

Only God could have known that the picture he gave Adam for the seventh letter of the Aleph-Beyt would one day have spiritual significance as it related to both the harvesting of fruit and the end times final harvest of the souls of men — a time that comes to a violent and finally a peaceful conclusion as *sin* is finally "cut off" and discarded forever and ever.

We are told that Jesus was "cut off". This was not a mistake, it was an accomplishment that is associated with Zayin and the number seven. It

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may be hard to fully grasp the truth of the matter, but when Jesus spoke those final words from the cross of Calvary, "It is finished.", He was announcing Divine Completion.

Consider the above as you review the meaning of the picture and number embedded in the seventh letter in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt.



# CHAPTER 9

# The Language of Omniscience



Contact with the Hebrew language brings you in contact with the Omniscient Creator!

Consider the omniscient foresight that went into designing the language of the perfect Garden of Eden in such a way that its full force and miraculous prophetic power was only fully manifest after sin entered the world.

Why is this?

The answer should be plain. God created a language that made the seemingly impossible transition from a sinless Garden to a sinful world of thorns and thistles, without losing but rather highlighting His original purpose.

# What was that original purpose?

The answer can be found in one word.

The word is the revelation of Messiah.

The Hebrew language is designed at its very root to communicate the message of Messianic atonement and redemption.

What we know as phonetic or conventional Hebrew was ordained by God to be the primary means of communicating His revelation to fallen mankind.

Without this gracious revelation where would we be?

I shudder to think!

That does not change the way God architected the language from the beginning — three complimentary languages disclosing one revelation.

Three-in-One, where have we heard that before?

Are the pictures and numbers the cheering section for the conventional Hebrew text?

The *number language* relies on the *conventional language* primarily but also on the *picture language* to give it meaning. Without the conventional Hebrew language, the numbers represented by each letter and the combination of letter/numbers would have no meaning, as their context is tied to both the pictures and the phonetic Hebrew.

At this point I need to clear up some confusion.

The language of the Garden, what we call Hebrew, was originally a 22-letter language that was written with no punctuation, no spaces between the letters, and no phonetic notations.

Each letter, or pictogram, was also two numbers.

One number is called the *place number*, and it is simply the number associated with the placement or position of each of the 22 pictograms in the Aleph-Beyt.

So, Aleph the first letter was number one. And, Tav the last letter was number 22.

The second number connected to each of the 22 letters compose a mathematical system that is pictured below in the early Hebrew pictograms. This number is called the *value number*, as it is the number God associated with each individual one of the 22 Hebrew letters.

Remember that Hebrew is read from right to left.

# Babylonian Exile results in the modification of the Hebrew Symbols

The following five Hebrew letters were altered, repeated, and then added to the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt during the Babylonian exile around 500 years BC. The five letters that were duplicated were given a numerical value number that does not correspond to the value number of the original early Hebrew.

The following alterations were made to the modern Hebrew block script.

These extra five variations on the already existing five letters are called "sofit" letters and are used when they occur at the end of a Hebrew word.

The five sofit letters with their new designated number are as follows:

For example:

83

# > Kaf is originally the number 20

The altered form of Kaf, used only at the end of a word based on modern Hebrew block script has now been associated with the number 500.

# Mem is the number 40

The altered form of Mem, used only at the end of a word based on modern Hebrew block script, is now the number 600.

# Noon is the number 50

The altered form of Noon, used only at the end of a word based on modern Hebrew block script, is now the number 700.

# Pey is the number 80

The altered form of Pey, used only at the end of a word based on modern Hebrew block script, is now the number 800.

# Tsade is the number 90

The altered form of Tsade, used only at the end of a word based on modern Hebrew block script, is now the number 900.

The addition of the five new variations of the already existing five Hebrew letters indicate the end of a Hebrew word.

These five new additions have also been introduced to increase the top end of the numeric system from 400 to 900.

Man thinks he can do better!



Left to the capricious schemes of man, we would all probably have multiple appendages and two sets of eyes so that we could walk in two directions at once while seeing both forwards and backwards.

Change after all is a good thing!

Right?

Consider the changes made to the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt while Judah was in captivity in Babylon.

Think of how it expanded the numbers and modified the pictures in such a way that they no longer were easily identifiable.

Are these good ideas?

They certainly must have thought so at the time, after all, who needs all these child-like pictograms as we are all grown-ups now? Can you hear the words of Jesus ringing in your ears?



# MATTHEW 11:25-26

At that time Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these thing from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes.

Even so, Father: for so it seemed good in thy sight.

None of these changes, which took place during the Babylonian captivity, have any Scriptural warrant, as they were not part of the original revelation from God.

This book will display the early Hebrew symbols and numbers, based on God's original disclosure, in addition to the modern Hebrew script that everyone is familiar with.



# This Far and No Farther

Mem is the picture of water and originally the number 40. Mem does not change to the number 600 just because some unnamed scribe, who had been banished to Babylon because of unbelief, decided to present it as a variation of the other altered letter Mem in order to give it a new numeric meaning when it comes at the end of a Hebrew word.

We have accommodated ourselves to the modern block Hebrew, since that is what everyone is familiar with.

We see no reason to change the number designation based on the changes made during the Babylonian captivity, which took place approximately 500 years before the birth of Jesus.

To keep things simple, we have decided to always include the earliest pictographic symbols.

These are the early symbols that were revealed to Moses by God — symbols all Israel could read.

Moses would be unable to read modern Hebrew without re-learning all the symbols since most bear little or no resemblance to the pictures they originally represent.


To be fair, there are a couple notable exceptions — proof positive that the Holy Spirit was present in Babylon making sure that the changes made in the pure language did not go beyond certain sovereignly ordained boundaries.

The picture and number translations used in the book are based on the earliest Hebrew pictograms and numbers. These are not only the most authentic and ancient, but they also clearly display the supernatural significance of the language gifted to Adam and preserved to this day.

Most Christians believe that the conventional Hebrew language stands alone as the single witness of God's revelation to mankind, as recorded in the anciet prophetic text we call the Old Testament.



Truly, the ancient prophetic, phonetic, and written text does *stand*. It does not stand alone as it was embedded from the beginning with prophetic pictures and numbers.



# God has incredible ways of getting into our imagination!

There is nothing more lucid than the biblical narrative revealed with the visual aids of pictures and numbers.

Pictures and numbers that were retained in a form that represented something man was familiar with — objects and symbols that would always be understood and would not change.

Obviously, carving a symbol into stone can be accomplished with the greatest ease by producing angular symbols. Using a stylus to press symbols into wet clay will allow for a more artistic representation. Penning it on parchment opens up yet another avenue of expression.

God did not give Adam a set of 22 flash cards with a prescribed picture that must be traced with exactitude. Rather, God put a picture into Adam's mind. It was a picture that could easily be understood and traced out in order to be easily figured out by all that viewed it.

These symbols were not designed by God to be difficult to decipher, just the opposite is true. A child could easily figure them out. The Hebrew language was not revealed to hide a secret. It was revealed to disclose everlasting *truth*, as its prophetic harbingers unfolded for all mankind to witness.

God was the one who linked the picture to a number. This was not only useful to Adam, whose intelligence was not challenged by the difficulty

of sorting out the meaning of both pictures and numbers at the same time. The pictures and numbers are also useful in the "here and now" as they are laden with theological and prophetic meaning.

Are we surprised that the spiritual significance of numbers and the child-like revelation of pictures has been hidden, corrupted, and finally packaged by those that hate God and His Son in a way that makes it toxic for Christians?

How many times have I heard that any attempt to understand the spiritual significance of numbers in Scripture is unwarranted, the devil's playground, and workshop for the Kabbalist and similar cults?

There are now at least two prominent enemies of truth, two liars.

Satan has raised up a legion of false priests who have corrupted the pictures and numbers originally revealed in the ancient prophetic text we call the Old Testament.

There is a second class of liars who claim to be defenders of the truth when in fact they are puffed up speed bumps who wish to defend people from the truth.

These self-appointed Bible police, without warrant or reason, accuse anyone that investigates numbers in Scripture of cooperating with the "dark side".

I don't know which lie is worse as they are both designed by the father of lies to prevent Christians from coming into contact with the spiritual significance of God's numbers as used in the Holy Scriptures.

This is not to say that there are not those that misuse the numbers and pictures of Scriptures, just as there are those that misuse the conventional text.

Do we ban the conventional text because there may be some who misuse it?



That has been tried in the past by those with a religious spirit and the results are evidenced by the sad and violent history that was emblematic of this devilish enterprise. Those who put themselves in charge of "dispensing" the truth themselves became complicit in mishandling, misinterpreting, and manipulating the Word of God.



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

## Sinner Come Home!

By the time you have finished meditating on the first six letters in the first word in the Bible, you can add two more words in front of *home*.

Do you know what they are?

### Come!

Come home!

Finally, you can add a third word.

### Sinner!

Sinner come home!

But how is this possible?

The first word in the Bible readily and without manipulation or persuasion gives up the answer as it gives us the unambiguous picture of the Son of God joined inexplicably to the mystery of the wooden cross!



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What do we discover when we read the carefully preserved pictures and consider the numbers revealed in God's love letter to mankind?

It is God's own Son!

# Pattern is Prophecy!

# God has incredible ways of getting into our imagination.

He might even draw His precious little children a picture or perhaps even 22 pictures. He might embolden each picture with a number. He might then use those pictures and numbers in His Word in order to reveal just exactly how He intends to love us.





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He might, and He did!

How did God love us?

Let's answer this question by providing two pictures — one from the Old Testament and the other from the New Testament.

If you doubt the significance and efficacy of pictographic revelation then you need to consider this simple illustration of the power of a picture.

We find the mysterious picture in the conventional Hebrew text followed by the revelation of the meaning of the picture by the very one whose shadow was lifted up on a wooden stake.





# History of Hebrew Language



Let's take a look at this from the beginning.

As we have previously established, Abram was the first person in the Bible to be called a Hebrew. A reference to Eber, the grandson of Noah, is cited in extra-biblical history as an antagonist of Nimrod. He was an outspoken opponent of the tyranny and seditious plots that were the foundational impetus for the building of the Tower of Babel.

Abraham is directly connected to the language Noah preserved as a living breathing testimony that the language of Eden remained the one gift God allowed fallen man to retain.

God did not begin to build His "holy nation" until Abraham was 100 years old. This would have been around 2000 years from creation and 400 years after the flood of Noah.

During that post-flood period, great nations sprung up all with different languages?

So, are we to be intimidated by the fact that the landscape is littered with pictographic languages that all were variations of the one language.

God did not eliminate the one language, the language of the Garden. He confused it. He jumbled it up so that it lost its supernatural revelatory majesty and power.

Are we to imagine that God confused the language of righteous Noah and the remnant seed of Shem, which included Abram?

Of course not.

Was there a nation called *Noah-Ville*, a large competing nation, alongside the Sumerians, Akkadians, Egyptians, Chinese and Phoenicians?

Noah and those in his family remembered the judgment of the flood.

Noah and his family retained the memory of God's grace.


Noah and his family remained faithful to the Lord.

Remember, it was a tiny remnant, who retained their knowledge and belief in God and His Word. This small group of men did not become a nation until God decided to make them His special people.

The Hebrews entered Egypt as a small seemingly insignificant family. *Four hundred years* later, they exited Egypt as a nation.

It was 400+ years from when God made the promise to Abraham that He would make of him a great nation.

That nation began with one miracle child named Isaac "Laughter", who was born when Abraham was 100 years old.




Qoof means - Behind - The Last - The Least

After nearly half a millennium, God fulfilled His promise to Abraham. Isaac, the miracle child of promise, was born when Abraham was 100 years old. He would become the offspring of a chosen people, a nation that would be forever connected to the promises of God.

# Are you beginning to get the picture?

Unearthing evidence of a language that resembled Hebrew after the flood and after the tower of Babel but before God promised Abram that he would be the father of a great nation, which would bring forth the Messiah, should not be a test of our faith.

It is obvious to anyone who simply believes the Bible and the biblical account as literal history. All that is left is to apply a little common sense.

God's Word is eternal and never changing. We are assured by the only one who cannot lie that His Word will endure forever!

Jesus reminded Satan, the great accuser and deceiver, that "Man does not live by bread alone but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God."

# What Word?

Was it the Word that God gifted Adam?

Was it the Word that was spoken without tutoring?

Was it the Word that did not evolve on the earth nor spring forth from sinful corrupted languages that followed in the wake of the judgment of Babel?

Was it the Word that was created fully formed in the heart, soul, and mind of the first man, which was preserved for all eternity and the only language God calls the pure language?

If you imagine that God allowed His Word, the Living Word that would miraculously be clothed with human flesh in order to save fallen mankind, to be birthed by the cursed and corrupted languages that were vomited out of the Tower of Babel then you need to rethink your understanding and bring it in line with revealed truth.

God has already supplied ample apologetic standards by which this matter can be judged.

Consider that nothing takes the Lord by surprise. So, we should not be surprised that His language is *self-authenticating*, set apart, and supernaturally transmitted in an instant to Adam. Finally, His language cannot be imitated.

How is that possible you might ask?

The next chapter will give you the answer.

# The Self-Authenticating Miracle Language of the Garden of Eden

Consider how the Hebrew "letters" are so closely identified with the picture and number that God originally linked to the script. In most cases, the name of the "letter" is also the very word that identifies the picture, and in the remaining cases the root words make it clear what is in view.

# The Assault on God's Word

The greatest change made to the original language of the Garden of Eden took place in, of all places, Babylon. Not at the Tower of Babel where God Himself confused the languages while at the same time preserving the one pure language of the Garden of Eden.



The first real change to the Hebrew language happened in Babylon, approximately 500 years before the birth of Jesus. The irony of this should not be lost.

The original pictographs that had endured for over 3400 years were stylistically changed to conform to the block Babylonian language we call Aramaic.

The original pictograms have not been lost. They exist and have been preserved in stone, in clay, and on parchment.

The assault that drastically refashioned the letters took place while Judah was in exile in Babylon, where God gave them over to their idolatrous passions.

Think about that for a moment!

But, the essence, the breath of God captured in the pictures and numbers could not be defaced. And, never will be, not even in the jaws of Babylon.

God will preserve His Word forever.

If it were not true you would not be reading this book.

To be clear, Enoch, Noah, Abraham, Jacob, Moses, David, and most of the prophets—save perhaps Daniel and the minor prophets—would not be able to read modern Hebrew.

Think about that for a moment.

No one but God could have ordained, from the beginning, a means of communicating His purpose and the divine portrait of His precious only begotten Son in a way that defied corruption, revealed God's unchanging plan to redeem mankind and yet was so simple to read that a child could understand it.

The Garden language we now call the Hebrew language is permanently bonded to the pictures and numbers that undergird it in order to memorialize forever the portrait and mission of His only begotten Son.

If you are a child of God, supernaturally indwelt by the Spirit of Truth that Yeshua promised would be the surety of every one of His precious flock, then you will hear His voice and follow Him.

You can hardly investigate a single Hebrew word, letter by letter, in the original pictographic script without the Son of God contemporizing Himself.

If you want a daily encounter with the Son of God, then read His Word daily. And, as you feast on the Words of Life you might consider adding in a Hebrew word study based on the pictures and numbers.

Open up your Hebrew Interlinear and find a Hebrew word that touches your heart. Take each letter and see what emerges from one single word when you investigate the pictures that compose the Hebrew word. Pray for direction from God's Spirit, just like you do when you read your English translation of His precious Word.

Keep in mind that God has preserved His written Word, and this should be the anchor-point for any investigation. If any interpretation appears to change or disagree with the conventional meaning of any word (vs. amplifying it), it requires more prayer and seeking.

The portrait that unfolds will very often pull your heart heavenward, alerting you to the fact that God's Word is living and active.

The Hebrew pictures and numbers do not contain another Gospel.

### God forbid!

Anyone who misuses the original pictures and numbers to create confusion is under the same curse as anyone who dishonestly commends false doctrine based on the phonetic Hebrew language. The pictures and numbers simply amplify and magnify the already abundant and generous revelation that God has given to anyone who reads His revelation in the plain text.

There is no battle between the conventional Hebrew revelation and the revelation in the pictures and numbers.

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Have you ever read an amplified New Testament?



The other plumbs the depths to discover things that are passed over quickly with no notice.

Water skiing and scuba diving are not at odds with one another.

They are both means of enjoying and investigating the same body of water, and there need be no quarrel between them.

Those who raise a controversy over the matter of Hebrew being pictographic are simply ignorant of the topic at hand or have some other agenda to push.

It is true that you can be aware of the conventional Hebrew language with no knowledge of the pictures and numbers that are structurally designed to underpin it, magnify its meaning, and amplify its message.

The millions of sinners who have come to Christ based on the clarion and clear revelation of the Word are testimony to the fact that nothing is missing in God's conventional original revelation. Even when translated into all the languages of the world, the Gospel summons men and women to put their faith and trust in Christ — no argument about that.

You can observe a sky scraper and climb its stairs without any knowledge of the steel beams that hold it up, but that does not change the fact that without the steel beams you would not be climbing the stairs.

The reality of the pictures and numbers is that both are embedded in and anchored the meaning of the conventional Hebrew language. This is an undeniable fact. You can ignore it or you can investigate it.

You have been given permission by the Savior Himself to search the Scriptures where you will find the Messiah on every page.

May your search both magnify and increase your love for the Savior who bled and died so that you might have eternal life based on Him and Him alone.

This book is not in competition with the hundreds of ways that God uses to bless, comfort, and encourage His people. It is not for everyone.

# Hebrew Word Study of Adam





Let's begin our Hebrew picture and number word study by looking at the name of the first man Adam.

The succulent juice from the fruit dripped off his chin and landed on the ground with a chilling clap.

The light, that had just moments before brightened his soul, dimmed and finally vanished.

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No longer clothed with luminous light, Adam glanced down in shock. His very first thoughts of unworthiness were so gripping that he fell to his knees and covered his eyes.

What was this overwhelming, crushing conviction he suddenly felt?

Shame had entered the garden!

He cringed holding himself tightly, bowed with the stabbing spasm in his chest and stomach.

Pain had entered the garden.

He slowly opened his eyes with his jaw clinched hoping the nightmare would pass. It did not. The heart of Adam was, in one terrible instant, broken. This breach left a chasm so deep it severed the bonds of love and fellowship between himself and his Creator, Elohim.

Sin had invaded the Garden of Eden.

It was a day Adam would never forget nor should we. It was a terrible day that seems to be lost in time.

None of our calendars memorialize this event. Yet, it is the most horrific tragic day in the history of mankind. It is a day that is conspicuous in its absence from the history books or almanacs. Books that chronicle every sort of misery but fail to ever mention the one event that is responsible for all war, disease, sickness, and death. 

But, before we leave the Garden, there is one last encounter with the Creator within the boundaries of the garden of probation.


#### One small hopeful Sign!

God is keeping mankind from advancing to his full potential.


#### The Great Irony!






## ATONEMENT English Translation

#### **KIPPUR**

Literal Hebrew



**Introduction:** The Day of Atonement or Yom Kippur was a ceremony initiated by God Himself. It began immediately after the deaths of Nadab and Abihu. These two sons of Aaron attempted to improve upon God's instructions for temple offerings. They had decided to add their own unauthorized fire offering to the Lord.

The Lord was not pleased with the "strange fire" the two sons of Aaron presumptuously offered in His presence. Their lives were taken and a great lesson regarding the *holiness* of God was temporarily learned.

Immediately after this event, God came to Moses and gave specific instructions regarding what the Lord called a **DAY of ATONEMENT**.

You can read the details of this in the 16th chapter of the book of Leviticus.

Even to this day, among the Jews The Day of Atonement is considered the most holy day in the entire year. The day is preceded by 10 days of fasting and prayer. The final day of these days of affliction ends on Tishri 10, the Day of Atonement.

While the Day of Atonement is still observed by the Jews, it is impossible for them to observe it as commanded by the Lord for the following reasons:

The Aaronic priesthood no longer functions. Because it does not presently exist it cannot perform the detailed rituals set out by God. Even if they did exist, the priesthood would be unable to memorialize the 10th of Tishri as

prescribed by God because there is no longer a tabernacle or a temple.

The holy sanctuary was destroyed by the Romans in 70 AD.

The congregation no longer congregates, the altar on which the sacrifices were to take place no longer exists, and the sacrifices ceased in the latter half of the first century AD.

The scarlet cord is no longer tied around the temple door on the Day Atonement. The scarlet cord that miraculously turned white as a sign from Heaven that atonement had been made.

The temple door no longer exists.

The scapegoat is no longer sent out of Jerusalem to die in the wilderness.

The Day of Atonement as prescribed by God no longer exists.

Despite the fact that the Day of Atonement can no longer be celebrated in the way prescribed by God, the day still remains as the most holy day of the year for religious Jews. It has been kept alive by observant Jews as best they are able considering that all the ceremonies, priests, offerings, altars, and geography that were necessary to carry out the strict instructions of the Lord God of Israel are either destroyed or in disarray.

#### There is one thing however that remains unchanged.

The one absolutely necessary thing that is able, once understood, to guide you to the place where full atonement can be found once and for all time.

This is the atonement that is absolutely necessary for anyone who wishes to spend eternity in the presence of the holy God of Israel.

This one thing can be discovered in one word.

It is a word that has a message hidden in it that can provide for the person who understands and by faith receives the atonement gift that has been graciously provided by the God of Israel.

Wouldn't you like to know how to have your sins blotted out and remembered no more?

The one word is *Kippur*. The word that is literally translated in Hebrew as propitation and is translated into English as *atonement*.

Now let's take a look at the miraculous message hidden in plain sight just under the three letters that compose one of the most amazing words in all of Scripture. The word **Kippur**.

The word translated in the English Bible as atonement.

The three letters in the Hebrew word Kippur are Kaf, Pey and Reysh.

Now let's see what is hidden in the three pictures that undergird these three Hebrew letters.



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The first letter in Kippur is Kaf. It is pictured as an open hand. The meaning of the picture is the palm of the hand that covers, or provides a covering, or that opens and allows something to be released.

It is the one letter that is connected with the concept of atonement or propitiation.

We are going to reveal this truth in the same way it was originally written as the language first dictated to Moses by YHVH picture/letter by picture/letter. This pure language spoken of by Zephaniah is the language we know today as Hebrew — the orriginal language of the Garden of Eden.

The First Picture/Letter in the Hebrew word Kippur is the letter Kaf.

**Kaf** is the **11th** letter in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt. It is pictured as an open Hand, Palm out and means – To Cover – A Cover – To Open – To Allow.



The Second Picture/Letter in the Hebrew word Kippur is the letter Pey.





**Pey** is the **17th** letter in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt. It is pictured as an open Mouth and means – To Speak – A Word – To Open – Mouth – To Cover.




The Third pictured/Letter in the Hebrew word Kippur is letter Reysh.

Reysh is pictured as the Head Person.

Redemption and eternal life are out of man's reach. Man is completely incapable of saving himself and apart from Divine intervention is doomed and damned.

So, let's take a minute and look at what we have learned so far about the Hebrew word Kippur based on the pictures and numbers.

We learn from the number meaning that the criminal is not standing before an earthly judge. He is on trial for the destiny of his very soul. He is standing before the One who can send him to Heaven or Hell. The crimes he has committed are crimes that send the offenders to Hell. He can offer

no defense for himself as he hangs his head awaiting his death sentence. But, then suddenly, there is silence in the courtroom as the Judge puts his

hand over his mouth and refuses to pass sentence of the guilty criminal.

In order to discover what happens next, we need to take a look at the one number that is displayed by Kippur.

## There is one Final Number in the Hebrew Word Atonement

If you asked a Jew to tell you what number he sees when he looks at the word Kippur (Kaf, Pey, Reysh), you would expect he would tell you that he sees the number 20, the number 80, and the number 200.

But that is not what he sees. He sees...

SHEEN W 300

Kaf 20 + Pey 80 + Reysh 200 = **SHEEN 300** 



So, what does **300**, the sum number of the Hebrew word Kippur mean?

**Three Hundred** (300 **W**) turns out to be one of the most amazing numbers in all of Scripture.

The meaning of Hebrew numbers can only be understood by searching the Scriptures alone in order to find out how and in what context the number is used.

In order to discover the meaning of the number 300 we need to investigate every time the number 300 is used in the Bible.

#### **GENESIS 5:22**

Enoch and the Number ( W 300) – Number of years Enoch walked with God before he was not, because God took him to Heaven. – GENESIS 5:22

Noah and the Number ( **W** 300) – The length in cubits of Noah's ark. **GENESIS 6:15** 

Gideon and the Number ( W 300) – And the Lord said unto Gideon, By the three hundred men that lapped will I save you, and deliver the Midianites into thine hand. JUDGES 6-7

Sampson and the Number ( W 300 ) - JUDGES 15:4

King David and the Number ( W 300 ) - 1 CHRONICLES 11:11

Enoch, Noah, Gideon, Samson, and David with his mighty men all had great victories. The thing that makes these three conquests unusual is that they can only be understood as you see the hand of God giving a **supernatural victory over enemies and death itself.** 

Does the number 300 show up in the New Testament?

The answer is yes!



Jesus Christ and the Number ( 300 ) – Mary of Bethany who anointed the body of Jesus just before His crucifixion is connected to the Number 300.



#### MARK 14:5

For it might have been sold for more than three hundred pence, and have been given to the poor. And they murmured against her.

The meaning of the number 300 in this story is immediately understood by simply reading the response of Jesus.



#### MARK 14:6-9

And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble ye her? She hath wrought a good work on me. For ye have the poor with you always, and whomsoever ye will ye may do them good: but me ye have not always. She hath done what she could: she is come a forehand to anoint my body to the burying. Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she hath done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her.



If we were to describe the meaning of the number 300, based on this verse alone, we might translate the meaning as follows:

The number 300 is a proclamation of the death and burial of Yeshua Ha-Mashiach, the Lord Jesus the Christ.

Jesus discloses that this story, including the number 300, is going to be published as a part of the gospel narrative as it is preached throughout the world.

So, to be clear, the number is not only associated with death and burial but also the good news that Christ is risen!

The number 300 is an awesome numeric reminder of the price that was paid for our redemption.

A summarization of all the verses could read as follows:

We have a certain hope that we will have victory over the final enemy of death, all because of the death, burial, and resurrection of Yeshua Ha-Mashiach, Jesus the Christ.

Now let's add what we have learned from the sum number of Kippur, the number 300.

#### **Summary of Picture and Numbers of Atonement**

We learn from the number meaning that the criminal is not standing before an earthly judge. He is on trial for the destiny of his very soul. He is standing before the Lord of Heaven, who can send him to Heaven or Hell.



The sinner can offer no defense for himself, as he hangs his head awaiting his death sentence. But, then suddenly, there is silence in the courtroom as the Lord puts His hand over His mouth and refused to pass sentence of the guilty criminal.


Someone has to pay the penalty for the sin of the criminal.

He announces that He will take the sinner's place, and He will take upon Himself all the sinner's iniquity.



#### **GENESIS 1:1**

In the beginning **GOD** Created the heaven and the earth.

**Introduction:** Let me introduce you to your Creator who has revealed Himself by name over 34 times in the first chapter of Genesis. It is only after introducing Himself as Elohim 35 times that He reveals that His name is also YHVH.

Elohim has also graciously disclosed the meaning of His name in pictures and numbers in order that you might understand and be wise.

It is no accident that Elohim is the third word in the first verse of the literal revelation we find in the ancient prophetic Scriptures known as the book of Genesis.

Elohim is the name we translate into English as *God.* The name Elohim is revealed 35 times between **Genesis 1:1** and **Genesis 2:4**.

YHVH, the second name God purposely revealed to man, is first declared in **Genesis 2:4**.



These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that YHVH (the Lord) ELOHIM (God) made the earth and the heavens.

Whenever you see the title God in your English Bible you should remember that behind that title is the name Elohim.

Whenever you see the title capitalized or emboldened word LORD in your English Bible you should remember that behind that title is the name YHVH.

The name Elohim is the first name revealed in the Scripture.

The name is revealed over 4000 times in Scriptures.

Please, be mindful that His name as Creator is Elohim.

The connection between Creator and Elohim is not always obvious in the conventional Hebrew translation of the name Elohim. The meaning becomes undeniable once you read the picture and number language hidden in the plain Hebrew text.

**Introduction:** Moses is the one man mentioned more often than any other man in the Scriptures.

There is little doubt that the Children of Israel, who were miraculously led out of the bondage of Egypt by Almighty God, were familiar with the meaning of the name of Moses. Moses was drawn out of the Nile river by the daughter of pharaoh and adopted into the royal family at the same time that Israelites were slaves in Egypt.

The name Moses bears witness to that miracle of deliverance from the water.

Moses was appointed and given authority by God to accomplish his mission as revealed by God.

Moses was a type of the coming Messiah, the Appointed One. Moses was appointed by God to deliver His people from the bondage of Egypt.

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To discover the meaning of the name Moses, we need to investigate the pictures and numbers of the three Hebrew letters that compose the name.

Keep in mind that what is now called Hebrew is the language given to Adam as a gift in Garden of Eden and was designed from the beginning to reveal, amplify, and magnify the Son of God.

# Translation of each Picture/Letter in Hebrew Word Moses

Mem is the 13th letter of the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt. It is pictured as Water and means – Liquid – Mighty Waters like the Ocean – Massive as the Waves of the Sea – Chaotic and Destructive like a Tsunami – Life-giving as Rain or the Clear Water found in a Well or a Brook.

The first letter in the name of Moses is Mem. Mem is pictured as Water. It can picture the calm water of a life-giving stream or the gentle rain that showers the earth, so that it might bring forth its bounty. Or, it can picture the violent and chaotic water of the ocean that brings destruction and death by way of floods and tsunamis. Water can be a picture of life or it can be a picture of death and destruction, chaos, and confusion.

The second letter in the name of Moses is Sheen. Sheen is pictured as Teeth. Sheen is a picture of pressing or gnashing. It can be the picture of destruction or of unmatched formidable power and strength. It is the one letter that God uses as His signature. It is an awesome and mysterious letter that should cause the reader to take special note of its meaning.



Hey is the 5th letter in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt.

It is pictured as a Man with Arms Raised to the Heavens and means –

To Look Upon Holy Spirit as the Revelator – To Behold.

The third, and final, letter in the name of Moses is the letter Hey. The letter Hey is pictured as a man lifting up his hands to Heaven. It is the picture of either proclaiming or receiving a revelation. It is a number often associated with God the Holy Spirit, the Great Revelator.

The picture meaning of the name of Moses is not very difficult to decipher.

This probationary period of testing has only been successfully overcome by one individual.

It is a price that none of us could ever pay since God could not be enticed by all the riches of this world to give us His Only Begotten Son as a sin offering. Yet, His great love has produced a gift to mankind that no amount of treasure could ever buy.

Moses is a faint shadow picture of the Messiah. And, the number 300 in his name is a harbinger of the death, burial, and resurrection of the Messiah. This is the foundation of what we call the Good News or Gospel of Jesus the Christ.

**5** reminds us that all of this is a result of freely given, undeserved favor.

The numbers in Moses are a harbinger of the coming Messiah, who has delivered us from the pain and penalty of sin and hell by shedding His precious blood as an atonement for our sin. This free gift is offered to all who will simply put their faith and trust in the risen Messiah, Yeshua Ha-Mashiach.



**Introduction:** Modern Jerusalem is the capital city of Israel. It is an ancient holy city and a center of pilgrimage for Jews, Christians, and Muslims. It was divided between Israel and Jordan in 1948. The Jordanian sector was annexed by Israel after the 1967 war.

Jerusalem has been the capital of Israel since 1950. And, it was recognized by the United States and many other countries as the official capital of Israel in December of 2017.

The first time Jerusalem is mentioned is in Joshua 10:1. It is ruled by a pagan king named Adonizedec. He is not just an ordinary pagan king; he is one of 22 giants mentioned in the Scriptures.

By the time you get to the 43rd verse of Joshua Chapter 10, Jerusalem is no longer ruled by the wicked king Adonizedec.

What happens in between is one of the most exciting and miraculous accounts in all of the Scripture. There is no question that Joshua 10:1-43 has prophetic implications that are harbingers of the last days, the final days before the coming of the Messiah to set up His Millennial Kingdom.

Listen to some of the strange and supernatural events that took place as recorded in the book of Joshua. Some of the elements of the account in Joshua 10 include: the sun and moon standing still, the kings of the earth hiding in caves, the destruction of the corrupted pagans by hailstones, and the siege of Jerusalem.

## Do these events sound strangely familiar?

If you read the book of Revelation, you will find many parallel accounts that God promises to unfold during the terminal generation who occupies the earth just prior to the second coming of the Messiah.

And, before you start feeling too sorry for all the wicked inhabitants of Jerusalem, who were destroyed by Joshua, keep in mind that these kingdoms that came against Israel were corrupted. They were not just morally corrupt but they actually had their DNA corrupted, and many were themselves hybridized - part human part Nephilim (fallen angels). Many of the Canaanites had become unrecognizable to the Creator, as they were a creature He had not created. The corruption was ubiquitous.

Keep in mind that pattern is very often prophecy.

Jesus told us that the last days would be like the days of Noah. In other words, mankind would have again corrupted himself or been corrupted by fallen angels and demons.

I would encourage you to read for your self the biblical account and connect the dots to the headlines that are now unfolding in present day Jerusalem.

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Can we read the headlines in any paper in any capital of the world and find the fulfillment of end time's prophecy? Are there prophecies unique to the last 70 years of this present age? Do we see prophecies that center around Israel and Jerusalem?

Are we witnessing prophecies that could only be fulfilled after the children of Israel miraculously returned to the land of Israel in 1948 and again occupied Jerusalem in 1967?

Are there prophecies that could not have been fulfilled between 70 AD and 1948, when the land of Israel was invaded and the children of Israel scattered to the four corners of the world? Could there be prophecies that would only unfold once Israel was re-established *one day* as a nation, as foretold in Isaiah 66:8?

Listen to what the prophet Isaiah revealed:

Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? or shall a nation be born at once? for as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children.

This prophecy was further fulfilled when Israel gained possession of their most precious earthly inheritance - **Jerusalem!** 



And, what is in store for Jerusalem now that God has brought His people back to the land?

This prophecy was fulfilled on May 14, 1948. And, you could have read about it in any paper from any capital city in the world. This headlne was published in advance by God, and reported by His prophet Zechariah in 580 BC — nearly 2500 years before it happened!

# ZECHARIAH 12:2-3

Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah and against Jerusalem.

And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all people: all that burden themselves with it shall be cut in pieces, though all the people of the earth be gathered together against it.

# Twin Pictorial Translations of the Word Jerusalem

The battle for Jerusalem, one of the oldest and the most contested piece of real estate in the history of the world, did *not* begin with the first Crusade sanctioned by Pope Urban 11 in 1095 AD.

The battle for Jerusalem is ancient and very significant, as you are about to discover.

Genesis 14:18 makes the first mention of a city called Salem. Most Jewish commentators believe this refers to Jerusalem, ruled by King Melchizedek.

The name Melchizedek is mentioned in both the Old Testament and the New Testament and is believed to be a "shadow type" of the Messiah. His name is reported to mean "My King is Righteous."

According to the Midrash (Jewish tradition), Jerusalem was founded by Shem and Eber, the forefathers of Abraham.



This would put the founding of Jerusalem immediately after the worldwide flood of Noah, somewhere around 2700 BC.

According to the Bible, the Israelites' history connected with Jerusalem in 1000 BC when King David occupied Jerusalem. Biblical evidence for temporarily destroying the city of Jerusalem is recorded much earlier, as Joshua is reported to have conquered the city and killed its king shortly after entering the Promised Land. But, Joshua did not occupy Jerusalem, and it remained under the control of the Jebusites until the 7th year or the reign of King David, who captured and inhabited the city for the last 33 years of his reign.

### 1 KINGS 2:11

And the days that David reigned over Israel were forty years: seven years reigned he in Hebron, and thirty and three years reigned he in Jerusalem.

While there is disagreement about which city is the "oldest city" in the world based on "continuous habitation", there is no question that Jerusalem is the most contested city in all of history.

During its long history, Jerusalem has been destroyed twice, besieged 23 times, attacked 52 times, and captured then recaptured 44 times.

The Bible first mentions Jerusalem in the 10th chapter of Joshua. This account holds the secret for understanding the hidden meaning and prophetic significance of Jerusalem. We will discover in the pictorial and numeric meaning that this is the foundation for the Hebrew word Jerusalem.

You cannot begin to fathom the enormous significance of Jerusalem until you understand one over-arching reality. It is the stunning reality that Abraham first glimpsed. It was a vision that seeded and watered his faith. It was a vision that made God smile on Abraham and bless him above all men. And, what was that vision that bolstered his faith and made God smile with pleasure?

Abraham was a pilgrim in this world, and he had his eyes not on any earthly city but on a city whose maker and builder was God.

#### **HEBREWS 11:8-10**

By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God.

#### HEBREWS 11:13-16

These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country. And truly, if they had been mindful of that country from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned. But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not ashamed to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city.

And, what was the name of the city that Abraham was envisioning by faith?

What is the name of the city that God has prepared for those that were strangers and pilgrims on the earth?

What was the blessed vision of those that received the promises of God by faith?

The answer is found in the last book of the Scriptures.



#### **REVELATION 3:12**

Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new **Jerusalem**, which cometh down out of heaven from my God:

#### **REVELATION 21:2**

And I John saw the holy city, new **Jerusalem**, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

#### **REVELATION 21:10**

And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy **Jerusalem**, descending out of heaven from God.

And, what is the future for Jerusalem prior to the New Jerusalem descending upon the earth from heaven?

The Scriptures foretell the glorious end of the earthly city called Jerusalem. Jerusalem will be established in peace and righteousness for 1000 years.

And, what will Jerusalem be called in this millennial period where Jerusalem is the capital of the entire world?

The answer is found in the Old Testament book of Jeremiah.

The Hebrew letter Vav seen in English as the **U**, the fourth letter in the English spelling of Jer-U-Salem separates the two Hebrew words spelled (Yood Reysh) and (Sheen Lamed Mem).

The letter Vav in conventional Hebrew is also the word and, a word that, just as it does in English, connects two things together. We might say "this and that", "apples and oranges", or "love and marriage". Everyone agrees that the second word in Jer U Salem, the Hebrew word Salem means peace.

The meaning of Salem is found in the root-verb Sheen, Lamed, Mem, and the word shalom. Shalom means un-brokenness and conveys the meaning of completeness or wholeness. How do the Scriptures use this word that indicates wholeness?

The answer is a payment that restores things to their fullness and wholeness. Does the word *propitiation* come to mind?

Salem means peace but not perhaps in the way we think it does! The first two letters in Jerusalem are Yood and Reysh.

The two letters Yood 🖵 Reysh 💎 compose the Hebrew word translated into English as fear or awe.



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Clearly, Yood Reysh , the first two letters in Jerusalem, are meant to instill in us a sense of *awe!* 

Whatever the nature of the *peace*, prophetically announced by the Hebrew word *shalom* or *salem*, it is going to, when it is fully disclosed, produce *fear* and *awe!* 

The conventional meaning of Jerusalem, the meaning the man on the street will report back to you if asked, is that Jerusalem means the "City of Peace." Is this correct?

Let's take a look at the meaning that the LORD has hidden in plain sight in the very letters and numbers that compose the one place on earth that God has put His name on, *Jerusalem*.

The first letter in the Hebrew name Jerusalem is Yood —. Yood is pictured as a Hand. It is an arm and a hand doing a mighty deed in order to





accomplish a divine mission. The second letter in the Hebrew name Jerusalem is Reysh . Reysh is pictured as a Head. Reysh is a picture of a person who is the leader, the master, the highest, and the Prince.

The translation of the first word in the Hebrew name Jerusalem could not be clearer. God has designed this revelation so that it might not be misunderstood. The first two letters in the Hebrew word Jerusalem announce that God is going to do a mighty work. Yood Reysh announces who is coming in order to do this mighty work.

The answer is found in the picture meaning of the Hebrew word Salem, the second word in the name of Jerusalem. Before we look at the picture meaning of Salem, we need to touch on the meaning of the third letter in the Hebrew word Jerusalem, the letter Vav.



In conventional Hebrew, the letter Vav means *and*. It is the letter in Hebrew that is pictured as an iron nail or a wooden hook. The iron nail and the wooden hook picture joining two things together, creating a connection between two things that are separated from each other.

It also has the meaning of making secure, as pictured by holding something up. We will return to the picture of the iron nail after we discover the picture meaning of Salem, the Hebrew word that is translated into English as *peace*.



The title LORD, capital L O R D, is displayed almost 7000 times in the Old Testament. As we read the Scriptures, we notice that there are scores of themes that just keep reoccurring which are directly connected to the

There is not a name of a place or any other person's name that shows up more often in the English translation of the Bible then the title LORD.

There are hundreds of verses that could be used to demonstrate the importance of His name. The Scriptures are packed with verses that instruct us in the ways we are to use His name.

name of the LORD.

Below are a few samples for you to consider, in order that we might answer this simple question.

# How are we to treat the name of the LORD?

We are not to take the name of the LORD in vain. In the literal Hebrew what we know as the third commandment actually informs Israel that His name is meant to bring about atonement, salvation, and life.

To misuse His name is the same as mischaracterizing the person represented by the name and, by so doing, to undue His purposes.

This is why the LORD is *jealous* of His name, as we are told in **Isaiah 42:8.** 

The Scriptures tell us to *declare* the name of the LORD throughout the earth. *Exodus* **9:16** 

The Scriptures tell us that His name is to be *published*. **Deuteronomy 32:3** 

His name is to be *glorified*. **1 Chronicles 16:8-10** 

We are to give thanks to the LORD. Psalms 92:1



We are to come against our enemies in the name of the LORD.

#### 1 Samuel 17:45

We are to praise the name of the LORD. Psalms 113:3

In **Isaiah 47:4** and in dozens of Scriptures we discover that the LORD is our *salvation and our redeemer*.

There are hundreds of other verses that bear witness to the praise, honor, and glory due His name. There are scores of verses that instruct us to lift up His name, to publish it, and to declare it throughout the earth.

There is even a special promise made to those who fear the LORD and meditate upon the meaning of His name.

# But do you know what there is NOT?

There is no place in the Bible where we are told to *hide* his name, to keep His name a secret, or to substitute His name for another name.

His name is written in the original Hebrew Scriptures almost 7000 times; no other name even comes close. There is nothing as important as His name!

So, here is the big question: What is His name?

If His name brings life, then as a poor sinner seeking life, don't you want to know His name?

Have you ever wondered *why* His name is not found in the Greek and English translations of the Scriptures?

Is His name being purposely hidden?

Many Christians do not realize that the English word "LORD", that is capital LORD, is simply a title. LORD is not a name. The title LORD appears nearly 7000 times in the ancient prophetic Hebrew Scriptures, which Christians call the Old Testament.

Almost 7000 times the true name of the one given the title LORD is covered up and hidden from our view.

What is his name, and what does it mean?

The answer is found in the original Hebrew Scriptures that we call the Old Testament. Those sacred Scriptures declare that His name is YHVH. Did YHVH ever instruct us to hide His name or substitute another name for His name?

The answer is *no*.




Probably the most well-known use of the Hebrew word for *bless* is located in Genesis:

The Messianic implications of this are staggering, when you consider that one of the names identified with the Messiah is Adam. Yeshua Ha Mashiach is the *last Adam*.









Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.

**Introduction:** The Hebrew word for *father* is Ab (or Av). Contrary to popular belief, the word Abba does not show up anywhere in the Hebrew Old Testament.

The Hebrew word for father is everywhere written as AB. The two-letter word Aleph Beyt is in the Hebrew Scripture to describe the Father.

There is some controversy surrounding the word "Abba" and its origins. Many believe this was an Aramaic way to express a familiar title equivalent to "daddy". However, some evidence suggests otherwise.

The thought of Abba being an Aramaic way of saying "daddy" was the suggestion of a 20th century scholar, Jeremias, and it was intended to be only a suggestion.

The New Testament term ABBA ( $\alpha\beta\beta\alpha$  in the Greek New Testament-always connected with "the Father") was thought to be "partnered"

with the term "pater" (father) to help the Greeks understand that Abba meant father. But, it seems strongly out of place. Especially, in light of the fact that in English Abba is transliterated, while Pater is translated.

Regardless of the etymological evidence, if you look at the Hebrew picture and numbers for the four letter word Abba and compare it to the two letter word Ab, you will immediately discover the difference of the two words. At the root, they do not mean the same thing. Since we are interested in what God has revealed, not what man has corrupted and accepted no matter how popular it has become, we will limit our investigation of the word father to the original two-letter Hebrew word for father.

Modern Hebrew today uses the word Abba as an intimate reference to father (daddy or papa). It is possible that oral tradition has carried this down from native Hebrew speakers throughout the generations.

Let's look at the original Hebrew as it relates to AB. In the conventional Hebrew, father is a word we all understand.

If someone is the father, he has children. A father is the head of a family.

We think of God as the father of His people. It is a word that presupposes relationships that connect one person who is the head or chief person to other people by natural birth or adoption of national kinship.

## Translation of each Picture/Letter in the Hebrew Word Father



Aleph is the 1st letter in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt. It is pictured as an Ox and means – a Strong Leader – First – God the Father.





Beyt is the 2nd letter in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt.

It is pictured as a Tent or House and means – House – Tent – Son –

Family – Dwelling Place – the Physical Tent or Body – Inside – Within –

First Letter in the Torah that identifies the Son of God.

#### **Picture Translation Of Father**

Aleph is the first letter in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt. The literal picture is that of an ox. The meaning would have been clear in the original Hebrew, as the ox was the symbol of both strength and leadership. The ox leads the cows and calves in its herd to safe pastures and protects them from predators.


**Beyt** is the second letter in the Hebrew Aleph-Beyt. The picture is literally of a house or tent.


Put the two letters together and you have the <del>V</del> Strong Leader and Protector □ of the House or Household.

God designed this word to have an ideal and a Messianic meaning.




Is there something else God wants us to see - something that would be corrupted if we simply went along with conventional and traditional thought and ignored the literal Hebrew word for father?

Himself would have been lost had we not used the original Hebrew


word for father.

	GIMEL	Pictured as a Camel. It means to lift up, to lift up with pride, exaltation, or to toil, and can be a picture of the Holy Spirit.
U	DALET	Pictured as a Door. It means of a doorway, to move in or out of something, a place of decision, an entrance to life or death, a place where change can take place.
4	HEY	Pictured as a Man with his Arms Lifted up to the Heavens. It means of behold, to reveal, to look upon, to pay attention to what follows, or the Holy Spirit as the revelator.
7	VAV	Pictured as a wooden Hook or a metal Nail. It means to secure, to join together, to bind together, or to connect two things together that are separated from one another.
